King Tut is known as the “boy king” of Ancient Egypt. He died before he reached the age of twenty. In 1922, his tomb was discovered in the Valley of the Kings by Howard Carter. The discovery of Tut’s tomb allowed a look into his history and death. His leg was broken when he died, and it’s possible that an infection killed him.

Some people believe that Tut’s tomb is cursed, because Lord Carnarvon, the man who paid for its excavation, died four months after the opening of the tomb.
