

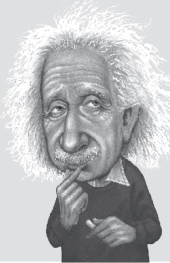
Historical Hair

Have you noticed that some well-known people have amazingly famous hair? Let's take a look at some historically famous hairdos.



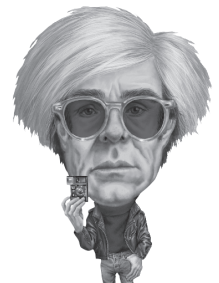
