As a boy growing up on a farm in Michigan in the 1860s, Ford loved to take apart watches and wind-up toys, and then put them back together.

In 1879, he moved to Detroit, Michigan, to learn more about engines and manufacturing. After spending some time working with Thomas Edison, Henry Ford founded the Ford Motor Company, where he would invent and build cars.
