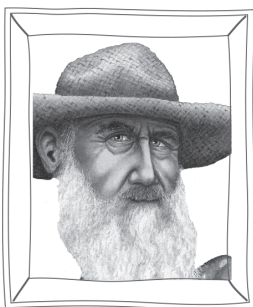
**Andy Warhol** was known for creating Pop Art using images of celebrities like Marilyn Monroe and Elvis Presley. He believed art could be about fun, cheap things, as well as serious, important things. He could often be seen wearing a silver wig and sunglasses.

**Frida Kahlo** was one of the most famous female artists of all time. Her real first name was Magdalena. Many of her paintings included religious symbols and images from Mexican folk art. One of her most famous paintings is called *What the Water Gave Me*.



**Pablo Picasso** started selling his art when he was nine years old, and he had his first art show when he was thirteen. Not one to stick with the same old style, he would try new and different ideas out as soon as he felt he had mastered one particular style of art. One critic described his painting as “the work of a madman.”

**Leonardo da Vinci** lived in Florence, Italy, in the 1400s. In addition to being a painter, he was an inventor, an engineer, a scientist, and a musician. His notebooks full of ideas and drawings are considered treasures today. His most famous painting is the *Mona Lisa*.



**Claude Monet** was a French painter known for working in a style called Impressionism. He believed that people should paint what they actually saw, rather than trying to make things look perfect. In addition to being a famous painter, he was quite well known for being a gardener. One of his most famous paintings is *Water Lilies*.
