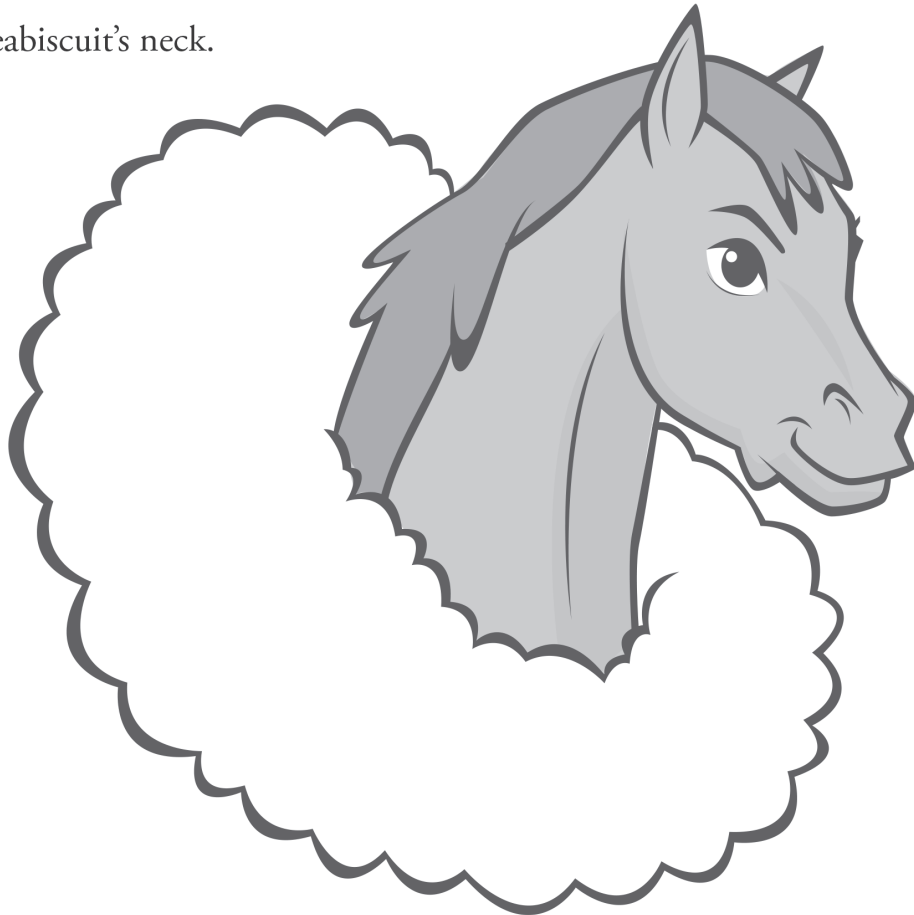


# Seabiscuit: An American Legend
